Modification Requested for Hazardous Waste Permit

The United States Department of Energy (DOE) Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to the Savannah River Site (SRS) 1992 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volumes III, IV and V. These modifications detail changes to the M-, F-, and H-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facilities (HWMFs) corrective action plans, respectively.

Revision 16 of Volume III provides a description of the permanent shutdown criteria for the Metallurgical Laboratory recovery well RWM-17D.

Revision 17 of Volume IV and Revision 18 of Volume V propose the addition of a surface water monitoring lo-

cation to the F- and H-Area surface water monitoring network in order to determine tritium flux.

This notice begins a 60 day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 15, 3 PM at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
