## Hazardous Waste Permit/Permit Application Modifications Requested

The United States Department of Energy (DOE) Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 2000 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volume VII for the Mixed Waste Management Facility.

The revision (Rev 10 of Volume VII) proposes to correct the limit of one groundwater protection standard, and modify the constituents in the detection monitoring program. The DOE-Savannah River Operations Office also has requested from SCDHEC modifications to the 2003 SRS Hazardous and Mixed Waste Permit, Module IVD for the Mixed Waste Management Facility. This request will modify the permit such that the groundwater protection standards and comprehensive monitoring constituents will be consistent with those proposed in the permit renewal application.

The DOE-Savannah River Operations Office also has requested from SCDHEC modifications to the 2003 SRS Hazardous and Mixed Waste Permit, Modules IVA, IVB, IVC, and IVE for the M-Area, F-Area, H-Area and Metallurgical Laboratory Hazardous Waste Management Facilities, respectively. This request will allow for the submittal of South Carolina certifications for new laboratories conducting sample analysis as required by the permit. SCDHEC has agreed that this is a Class 1 modification that does not require SCDHEC approval prior to implementation.

This notice begins a 60-day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 25, 3 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written Comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered
