## Class 2 Hazardous Waste Permit Modifications Requested at the Savannah River Site

The Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 2000 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volume VIII, the Mixed Waste Storage Buildings (MWSB), and Volume XIII, the Transuranic (TRU) Pads 3-6, 14-19 & 26.

The MWSB revision (rev 6 of Volume VIII) proposes upgrading the fire water system by replacing the 15,000 gallon firewater bladder with a permanently installed firewater piping system complete with three new fire hydrants and clarifies the applicability of the RCRA air emission standards for containers of waste at the MWSB. The revision also proposes updates to the MWSB Contingency Plan information (i.e. emergency points of contact, emergency equipment, etc.) and several other minor changes.

The TRU Pads revision (rev 4 of Volume XIII) proposes to clarify the applicability of the RCRA air emission standards for containers of waste at the TRU Pads. The revision also proposes updates to the TRU Pad facility Contingency Plan information (i.e. emergency points of contact, emergency equipment, etc.) and several other minor changes.

This notice begins a 60-day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 23, 2:30 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written Comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
